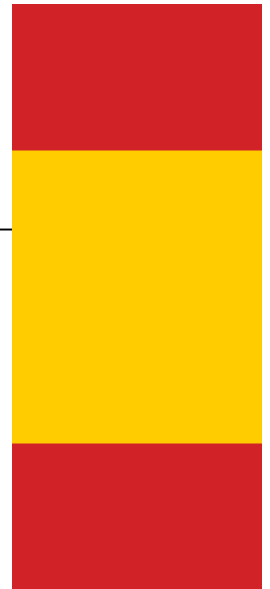

Orientation

- Team Groups (Age 3 – 12)
 - Psychologist or Pedagogue (depending on the place)
 - Social workers
 - For pre-primary and primary schools

- Counselling Department (Age 12 – 18)
 - Psychologist or Pedagogue (1)
 - Social worker (1). It depends kind of social problems.
 - Special needs teacher (1) and language teacher
 - Teachers who are working in different programmes destined for pupils with learning disabilities

Your target group and the way you reach them:

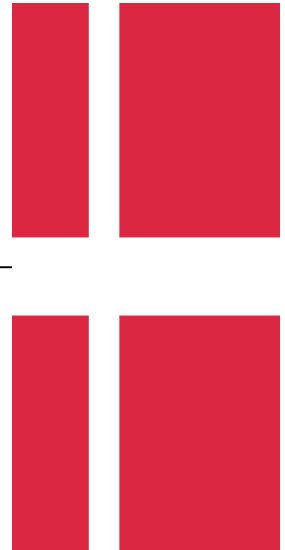
- Team Group and Counselling Department
 - Direct Intervention
 - Inside and outside the classrooms
 - Meetings with families, teachers and social workers
 - Assessment
 - Design with other teachers paying attention to special needs

What kind of services do you provide to your target group?

 - Diagnostic and design the action
 - Assessment
 - Collaboration with families and teachers to improve the pupils' results
 - Information

- Counselling Department
 - Assessment
 - Career counselling
 - Information about job searching
 - Training (Developing skills for looking a job)
 - Collaboration in the activities organised by the department
 - Collaboration in design and development of special programmes to deal with learning disabilities

Organisation:

District North Copenhagen:

- 45 public basic schools
- 16 private basic schools
- 25 education counsellors
- 11 youth counsellors
- Found and funded by the local government

Target Groups:

- Educational guidance
⇒ 6th – 9th (10th) grade
- Youth counsellors
⇒ Dropouts

- Part time Counsellors / Teachers at vocational and secondary schools
(not a part of local government's responsibility – funded by the state!!!)

Services and Objectives:

Career information + career guidance counselling (6th to 10th grade in basic schools)

- A) Vocational information in cooperation with the teachers
- B) School visits (secondary and vocational schools) / vocational practical visits
- C) Personal interviews (8th + 9th grade)
- D) Educational planning / studying
- E) Information meetings with parents and students about the educational systems

Organisation:

School guidance and psychology service = SPOS
(Service de Psychologue et d'Orientation Scolaire)
in a secondary school in Esch /A (Luxembourg)
(1300 students, 12-19; ≈130 teachers)

- ⇒ Team of psychologists, social workers and teachers
- ⇒ Office in school

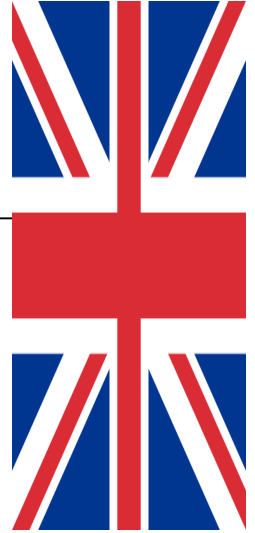

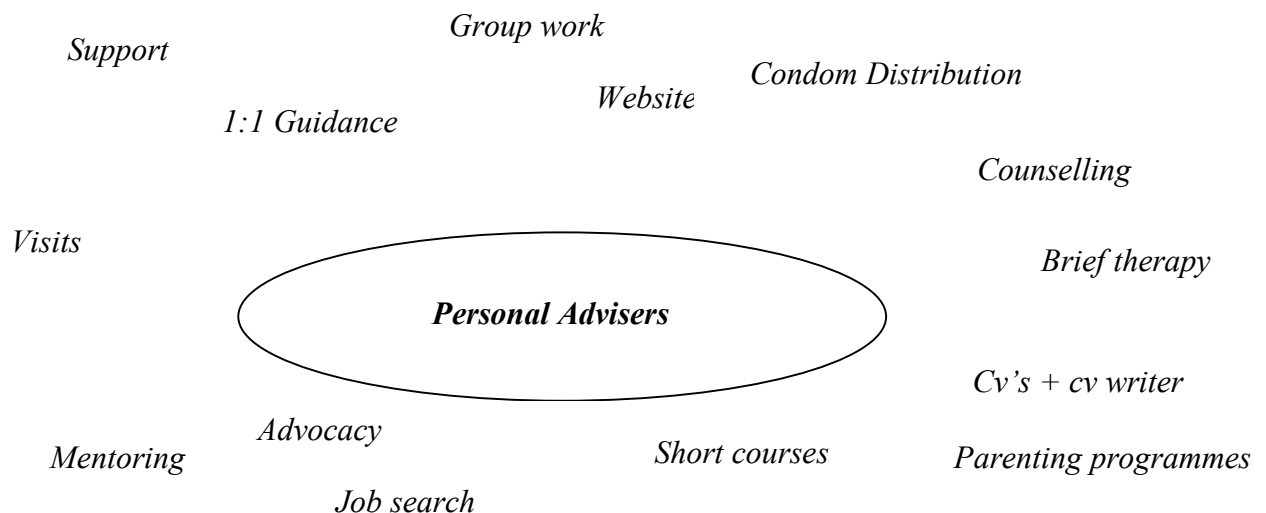

The ways you reach them:

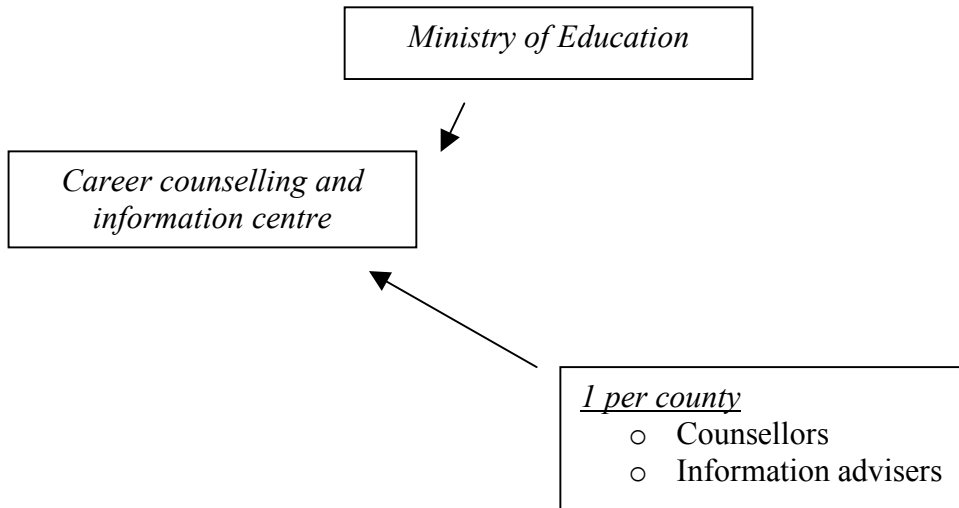
- Home visits

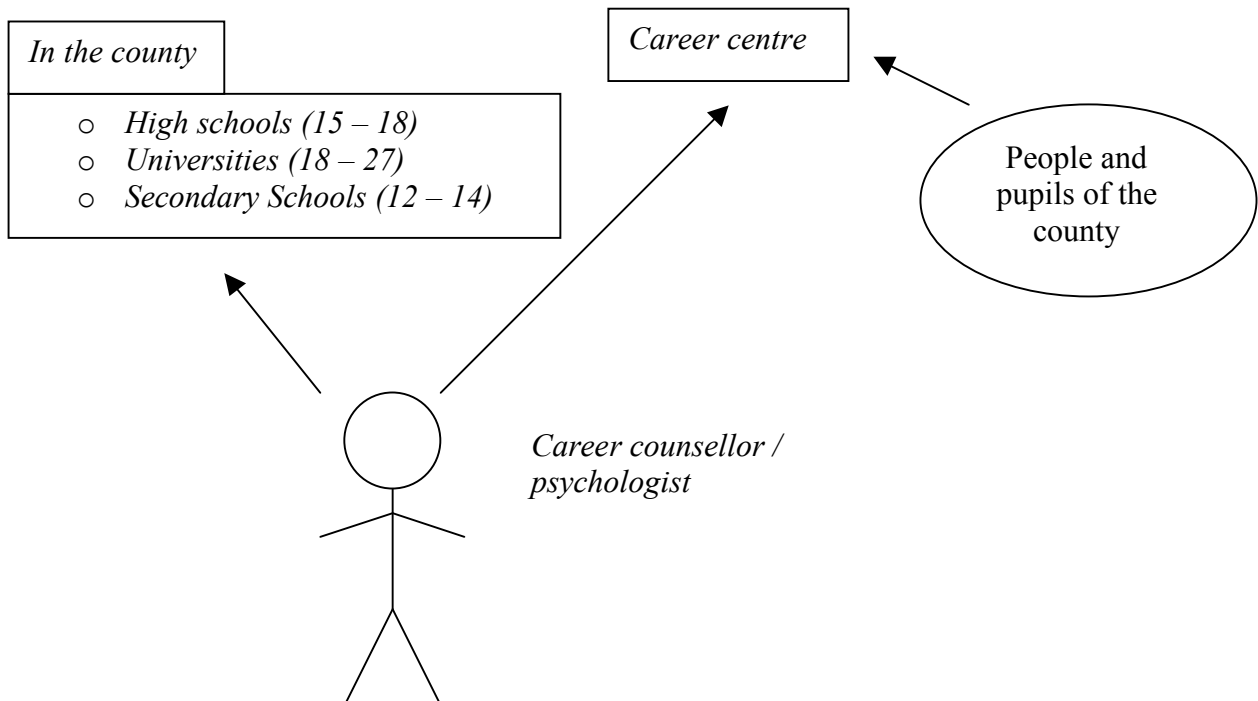

What kind of services do you provide to your target group?

- Career Counselling interviews
- Test assessment – (Wise – Rorschach – TAT, etc...) ⇒ disabilities commissions
- Career information lectures / presentations (class/ parents)
- Partnership with job caster – vocational school visits – company visits

About developing student enterprise:

- Job clubs
- Private and public funds and grants
- Tax reduction offers in the beginning
- Incubators for start – ups

About labour market board's activities towards the youth:

- Shadow job week: compulsory for every 9th grade pupils
