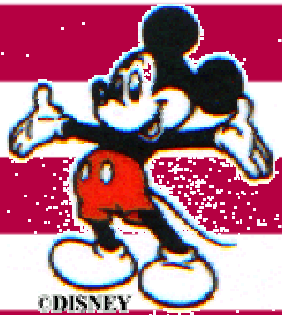
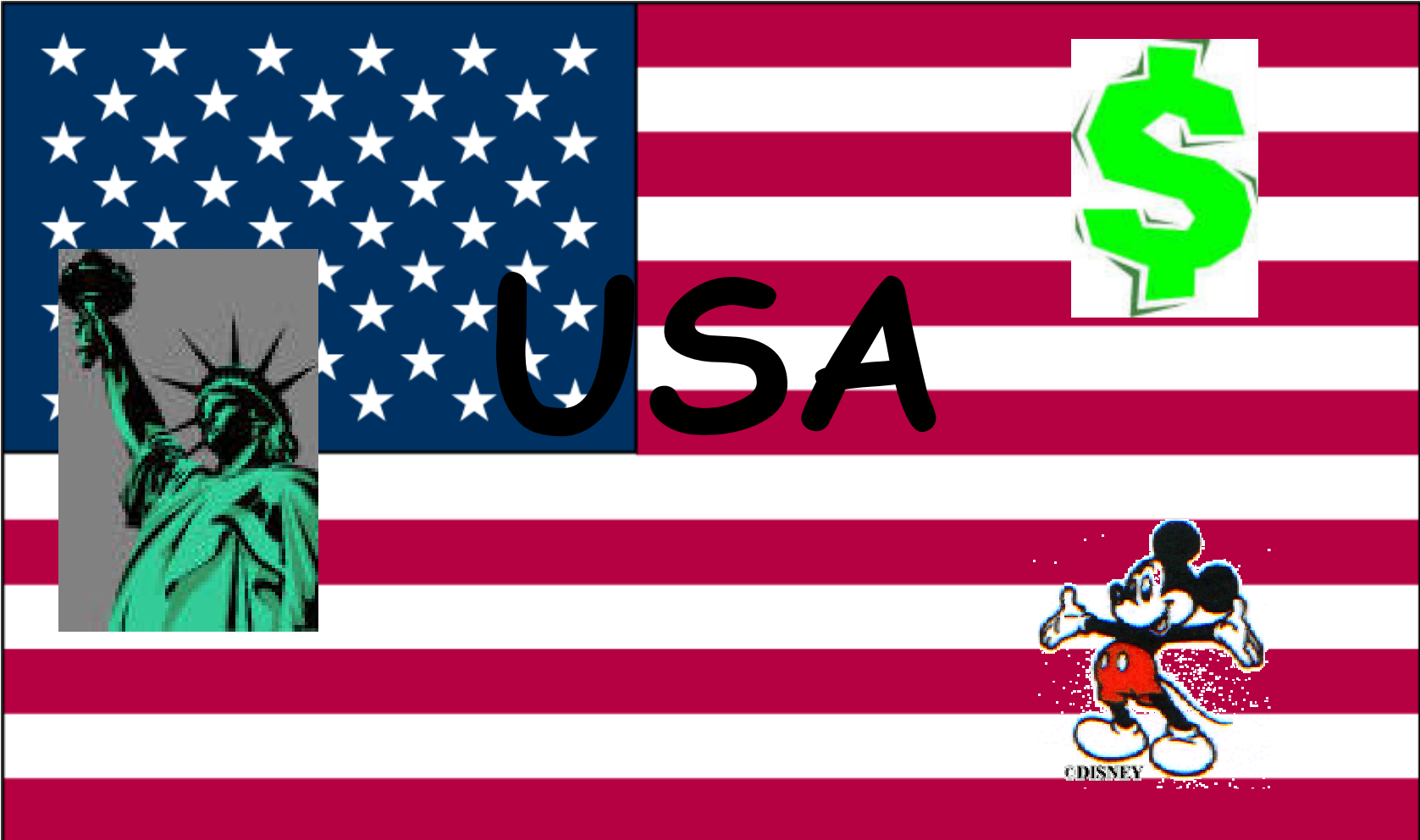
TIME REQUIRED	10 – 15 minutes

HOW RESOURCE(S) CAN BE USED	<p>Stick pictures of 4 holiday locations on each wall. Make sure chairs/tables are placed out of the way. Ask students to identify which location they would choose for a holiday and stand by the appropriate picture. Place a sheet on OHP, which gives additional information about each place. Ask them to consider their choice and if they would now like to change location. Repeat twice more, giving new information each time.</p> <p>At the end of the game ask students to discuss how and why they may have changed their mind - for example a destination that may have initially seemed attractive may be less so when further information about the holiday is provided. Encourages students to consider how impulsive decisions can lead to poor/inappropriate choices (relate to college courses, employment and training).</p>

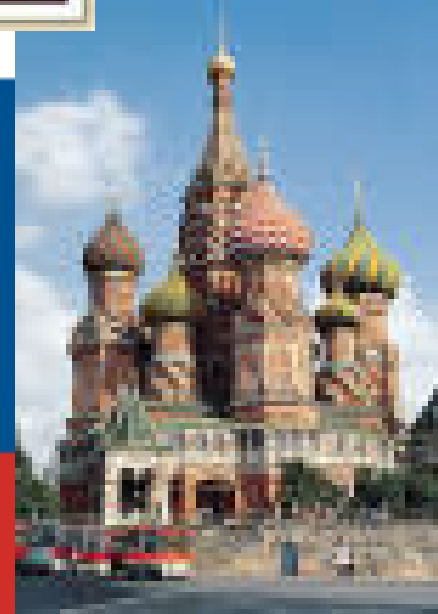
Destination Information: USA Ibiza Russia Weston-Super-Mare (a dirty English seaside resort)

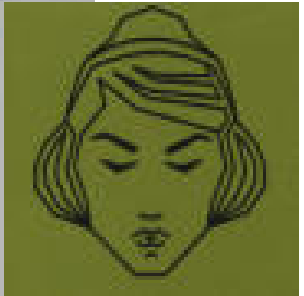
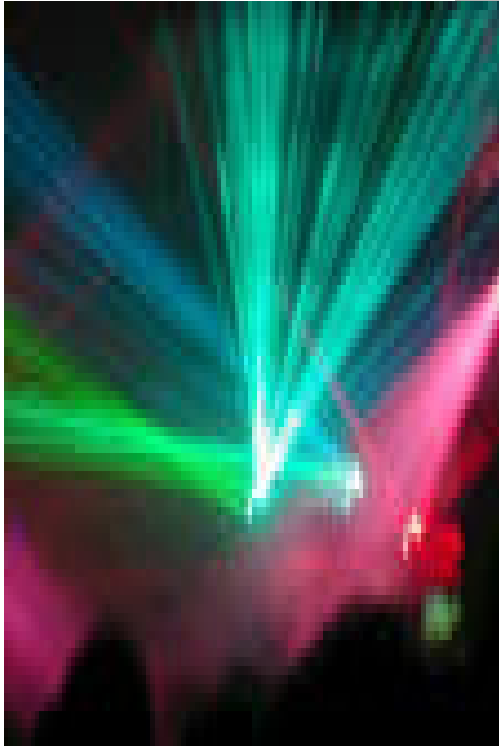
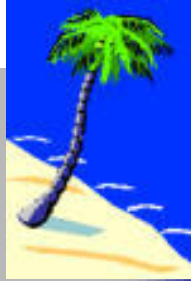

In Weston you'll get £1000 spending money as part of the holiday

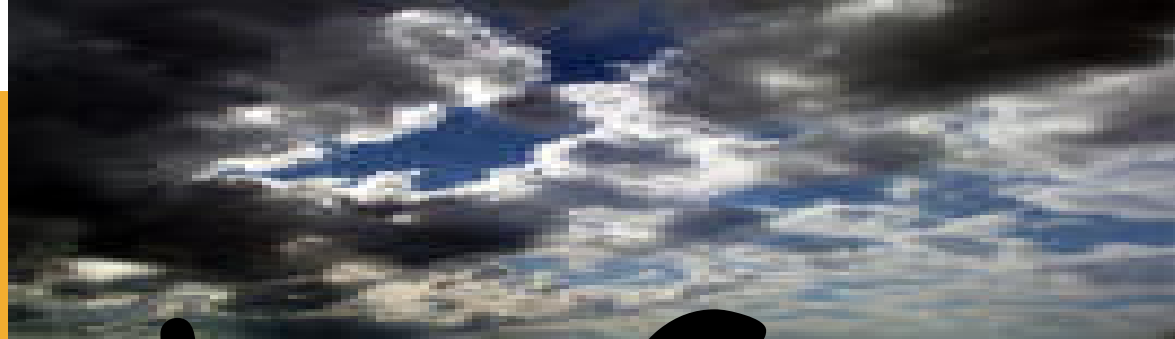
