Mobility: Estonia-Finland



From Estonia to Finland:

- daily commuting is estimated to be less relevant than weekly or seasonal rhythms
- the Estonian commuters predominantly work in the branches of agriculture, construction or transport, the sectors of health or hotels still play a certain role

From Finland to Estonia:

- commuting in this direction is manifest mainly in weekly rhythms
- Finns' commuting is related to Finnish firms' investments in Estonia
- commuters are involved sectors of business services, transports and agriculture

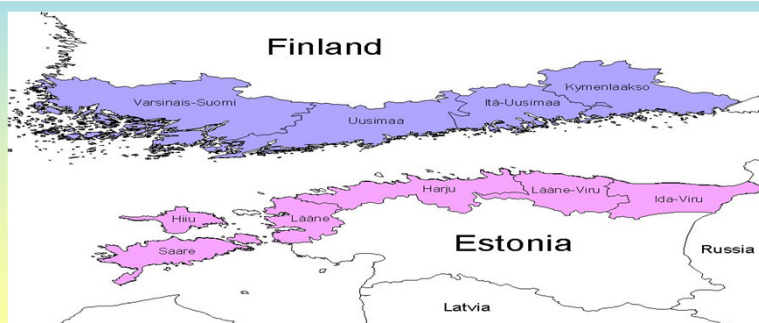

From Estonia to Finland	20 000	2.06
From Finland to Estonia	1250	0.29

Characteristic:

- Majority would like to work abroad only temporarily
- 60% jobseekers are looking for non-skilled job (they are skilled themselves)
Cleaners, factory workers, care workers, fruits-vegetables pickers
- Main reason at the moment is, that they can't find a job in Estonia or like to earn extra money in summer time.
- Age group : 25-50 years old (50/50 women and men)
- 66% of our clients are registered unemployed

EURES clients

- Clients who would like to go abroad to do any job
 - long-term unemployed people or very young people
- Clients who already know where they want to go
 - often have already got a job offer
- Clients who are coming back to Estonia from another EU country
 - problems with foreign employer, U1, tax returns
- Clients who are involved with our projects
 - General information about CVs, motivation letters, interview arrangements, living and working conditions of the country where the future job will be
